ACCESS TO BOOKS AND RECORDS

POLICY NO. 4

In accordance with the Texas Bylaws, Section 4.01(b), Access to Books and Records, the Highway District 2 Credit Union books of accounts and other records will be made available as follows:

- 1. At all times to the Highway District 2 Credit Union Board of Directors.
- 2. An agency of the Federal and State Government as required by law or regulation.
- 3. When directed by the Texas Credit Union Department.
- 4. The Audit Firm or Committee to perform their responsibility.
- 5. A member may have access to Articles of Incorporation, bylaws, rules, guidelines, board policies and copies thereof by submitting a written request to the Highway District 2 Credit Union Manager five (5) days prior to date of inspection.

In accordance with the Texas Credit Unions Laws & Regulations, Section 91.315, Members' may have access to the Highway District 2 Credit Union's most recent version of the following documents:

- a. Balance sheet and income statement
- b. A summary of the most recent annual audit
- c. Internal Revenue Service Form 990

In accordance with Section 91.310 of Texas Credit Unions Law & Regulations, an annual report will be available to all members before the credit union's annual meeting. The report will include the following:

- a. Names and dates of expiration of the terms of office for each director.
- b. Names of any honorary or advisory directors appointed by the board.
- c. Description of any changes since the last report to the credit union's management staff, bylaws or articles of incorporation, financial condition and operating results and membership size and services offered.
- d. Credit union's year end balance sheet and income/expense statement.
