BOARD OF DIRECTORS REPORT DECEMBER 31, 2024

To the Highway District 2 Credit Union Members:

We, the Board of Directors, are elected by the membership to establish goals and give direction to the operation of our credit union in a sound business manner and in compliance with State and Federal laws and regulations. The daily operation is placed in the hands of the staff that serve you.

The Highway District 2 Credit Union earned a nice profit in 2024. Steadily increasing Interest rates on investments and loans were the main reason for the profit. A net profit of \$49,912.76 was recorded for the year. Compared to 2023, this was an increase in income of \$30,349.

The Highway District 2 Credit Union is well capitalized in accordance with the regulations set forth by the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA). A minimum net worth ratio of 7% is considered to be well capitalized. The Highway District 2 Credit Union net worth ratio is 28%.

The Highway District 2 Credit Union paid dividend rates competitive with on-demand accounts (funds available without early withdrawal penalty) in other financial institutions. Dividends are declared and paid quarterly.

Loan demand increased from \$1,018,892 in 2023 to \$1,064,680 in 2024. Average yield on loans increased from 5.8388% in 2023 to 6.23% in 2024. The Credit Union continued to be competitive on the pricing of interest rates for new and used vehicles.

Membership decreased from 701 in 2023 to 681 in 2024. Share account balances decreased from \$3,650,258.45 in 2023 to \$3,450,224.83 in 2024.

Earnings on the Credit Union investments increased approximately \$40,741.62 in 2024.

Finally, let me say thanks to the staff, Dania Pearson and Robin Scarberry, who handle the daily business of our credit union.

Your comments are always welcomed. It is our goal to give you the best service possible.
